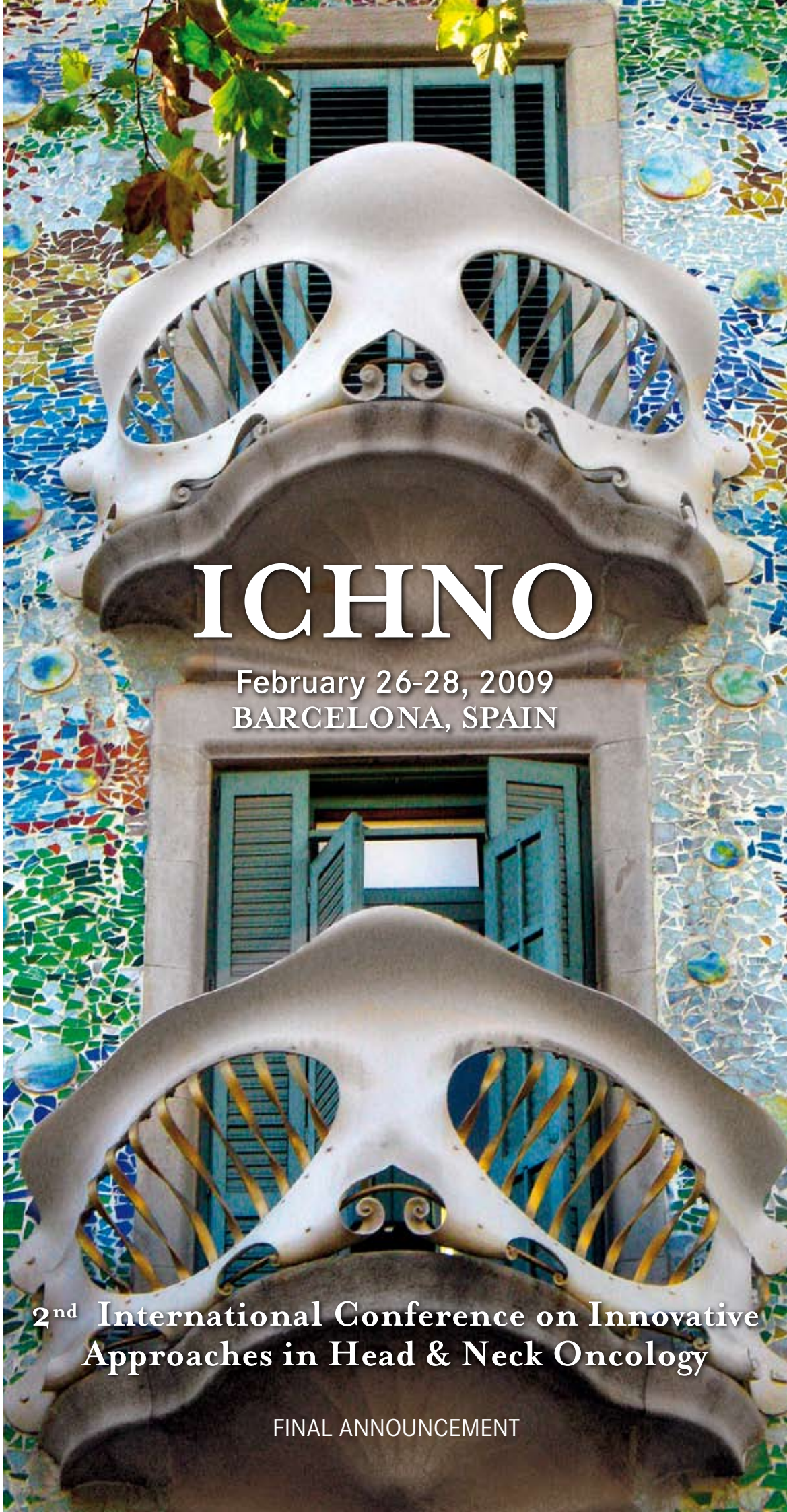
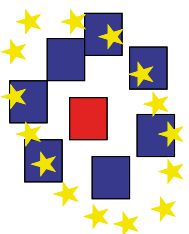

GUIDELINES FOR SUBMISSION OF ABSTRACTS

Note: Only one abstract as presenting author can be submitted

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

Abstracts must be submitted on-line, through the ESTRO website: www.estro.org

Please follow the instructions on the screen.

For questions regarding the on-line submission process, please e-mail: maria.sapriz@estro.be

- When finished with the on-line submission, it is imperative to click the “submit” button for final submission of the abstract; a message will then appear informing you that the abstract has been registered successfully. The presenting author will receive an e-mail confirming that ESTRO has received the abstract. This confirmation of abstract receipt is NOT a notice of acceptance of your abstract.
- In case no confirmation from ESTRO is received, the presenting author should contact maria.sapriz@estro.be within one week after submission of the abstract.
- Submitting an abstract for presentation does not constitute registration for the conference. Abstract presenters must register to attend the conference by following the instructions for on-line registration (www.estro.org/events/meetings).
- Once the abstract is submitted, changes, corrections or rewording are possible until October 11, 2008. Careful typing and proofreading are essential, as the abstract will be published as submitted.

REGULATIONS

- The presenting author is obliged to ascertain that all authors are aware of the content of the abstract before submission to ESTRO.
- The presenter and co-authors must identify any financial interest in products or processes described in the abstract.
- In submitting an abstract, the authors accept that the information to be reported is for exclusive presentation in the session to which the abstract will be assigned if accepted. This information should not be presented at a commercially sponsored satellite symposium.
- Abstracts must be submitted and presented at the conference in English.
- Notification of receipt and acceptance will be sent only to the presenting authors.

a. General information:

Authors will be asked to select the following:

1. Topic category: choose the topic category that refers to the main subject of the abstract. The scientific Committee has the authority to re-categorise the abstract.
2. Presentation preference: authors should indicate the presentation preference (oral, poster or no preference). Please note that the final decision on the presentation format will be made by the Scientific Committee
3. Select your public preference for presentation
4. Keywords: authors have to provide 1 to 3 keywords (different from category).

b. Abstract format

- Abstracts titles should be brief and reflect the content of the abstract. The title (max.100 characters) is important since it focuses attention (it is the “showcase” for the presentation). Do not use upper case letters in the title except for words that are always capitalised and do not use non-standard abbreviations.
- Abstracts should be structured as follows: 1) Purpose; 2) Material; 3) Results; 4) Conclusion.
- The use of standard abbreviations is desirable. A special or unusual abbreviation must be placed (in round brackets) after the first appearance of the word for which it stands.
- The on-line abstract submission procedure will not accept abstracts that exceed 2500 characters including spaces (body of the abstract).
- **Authors can include only one figure table or black/white illustration** (maximum width 7 cm). Colour illustrations will be printed in black/white in the abstract book.
- Equations can be inserted using LaTeX.
- The preferred font is Verdana 7.

ABSTRACT SELECTION PROCESS

Abstracts submitted for presentation will be reviewed by an international panel of experts in the field of the subject.

Abstracts will be selected for one of the following presentation formats:

- Oral presentation: the abstract is selected for oral presentation at any of the proffered paper sessions.
- Poster presentation: abstracts that have been selected for presentation in a poster format. The posters are grouped by topic and are displayed throughout the meeting.

Abstracts selected for oral or poster presentation should be presented at the conference. The author of the abstract should be registered to the conference.

TRAVEL INFORMATION

How to reach Barcelona

El Prat International Airport is six miles (10 kilometres) south-west of the centre of Barcelona and taxis are available at the airport 24 hours a day. It takes about twenty minutes into the centre of town and the fare is about 18 €. There's a RENFE train every 30 minutes to Sants Station (central Barcelona) from 6:00 am to 10:30 pm The fare is about 1.80 € and the journey takes about 16 minutes in air-conditioned trains with plenty of luggage space.

Public transport in Barcelona

- The subway is the easiest and fastest way of moving around the city.
- Barcelona has got 2 different systems, the subway with its 5 lines and the FCG, with 2 lines in Barcelona and 4 more lines going to nearby towns.
- The bus is certainly a slower transportation but it allows you to enjoy the city views while moving around.
- Black and yellow cabs show a green light when free. Just wave your hand to call them. The meter (it is compulsory to use them) will indicate the price to pay, but an extra fee is charged when taking it at the airport or when you carry luggage with you, etc. Prices are shown on a sticker inside the cab.

How to reach the congress centre

The Catalunya Palace of Congresses is located on Barcelona's main avenue, the Diagonal, and has easy access to the airport, harbour, train stations and motorways to Madrid, France and the Mediterranean Coastline.
