This is a great opportunity for you to receive information about the research and training possibilities in these institutions at first hand and also for those who are currently in, or have completed exchange programmes will share their experiences.

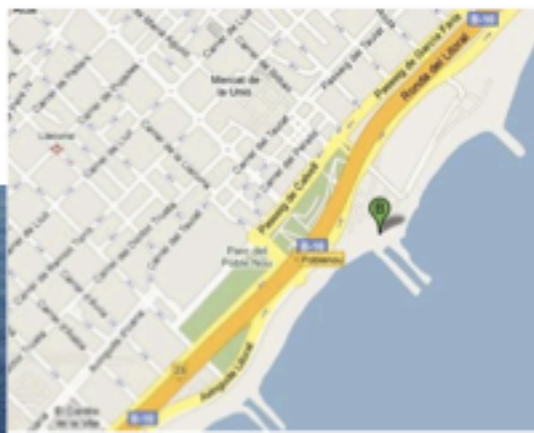
