I would like to bring to your attention the 12th International Conference on Electronic *Patient* Imaging, **EPI2k12**, taking place in Sydney 2012. The conference on Electronic *Patient* Imaging takes place biennially at alternating venues around the globe, and was last held in Belgium in 2010. The aim of the conference is to gather the international Electronic *Patient* Imaging community, and create a forum for discussion and dissemination of clinical achievements and future developments.

A stimulating and intense program for EPI2k12 in Sydney has been planned, with invited lectures from internationally renowned speakers, refresher courses, scientific sessions, posters, and on-site, practical demonstrations at various hospitals located around the Sydney CBD area. In addition, delegates will have the opportunity to attend vendor Q&A, troubleshooting tips, tutorials and a research symposium, all included in the registration fee.

The conference will be held at the centrally located FourPoints Sheraton Hotel, Darling Harbour, Sydney from 12-14 March 2012, with the practical workshops held on 11 March 2012. The welcome reception and conference dinner will be held at venues chosen to showcase our lively city and lovely harbour.
